



Rules of the "Name the Track" Contest

version as of July 14, 2026

§ 1. GENERAL PROVISIONS

1. This document ("**Rules**") sets out the terms and conditions of participation in the "Name the Track" contest ("**Contest**") organized by Rebel Wolves sp. o.o. with its registered office in Warsaw, Dereniowa 60 lok. U4, (02-776) Warsaw, entered into the Register of Entrepreneurs of the National Court Register kept by the District Court for the capital city of Warsaw in Warsaw, XIII Commercial Division, under KRS number 0000933935, NIP: 9512529961 (hereinafter referred to as "**We**" or "**Rebel Wolves**").
2. Rebel Wolves invites all users of the Channels who are natural persons (hereinafter referred to as "**You**" or "**Participant**") to participate in the Contest to come up with new titles for selected songs/musical compositions ("**Song**") derived from our video game "The Blood of Dawnwalker" ("**Game**").
3. The Contest takes place on the following Rebel Wolves social media channels: X, Instagram, Reddit and Discord (the "**Channels**").
4. The Rules define the rules of the Contest, including the types of prizes and the method of obtaining them by the Participants.

§ 2. PARTICIPANTS

1. The Contest is open to Participants who are at least 18 years of age on the day of entering the Contest at the latest and have full legal capacity. In practice, this means that the Participant may effectively conclude contracts on their own behalf, bear the obligations arising from them and is independently responsible for their actions in connection with participation in the Contest.
2. Employees, associates or family members of employees or associates of Rebel Wolves, as well as other persons involved in the preparation and conduct of the Contest, are not eligible to participate in the Contest.

§ 3. RULES OF THE CONTEST

1. The Contest takes place in three editions, each edition takes place on a different Channel. Each edition of the Contest begins upon Our publication, on the selected Channel, of the Song for which Participants are to come up with a title. Rebel Wolves reserves the right to suspend the start of the next edition of the Contest.

2. In order to participate in the Contest, the Participant must submit their proposal for a new title for the Song in the comment under the post featuring the Song ("**Entry**"). The Entry must be made in English, Entries in other languages will be rejected. Depending on the edition of the Contest, Entries must be submitted by commenting under the post on the following Channels:
 - a. **Edition I** – X;
 - b. **Edition II** – Instagram;
 - c. **Edition III** – Reddit or Discord.
3. During each edition of the Contest, the Participant may make only one Entry (i.e. place one comment under the post). If You submit more Entries, We will only consider the Entry made at the earliest.
4. Participants may participate in the Contest only individually. This means that if You create an Entry with another user, that Entry will not be eligible to participate in the Contest.
5. Entries must be the result of the Participant's individual creation and must not infringe the copyright or other rights of any third party. The Entries must not be generated, in whole or in part, using artificial intelligence (AI) tools, or constitute alterations of content generated by such tools.
6. In addition, the Entries must not be unlawful. This means that the Entries may not, in particular:
 - a. contain personal data;
 - b. be discriminatory or offensive to religious sensibilities;
 - c. violate the law or the rights of third parties;
 - d. contain vulgar or offensive, political or propaganda content;
 - e. contain pornographic or obscene content;
 - f. contain advertising content, registered names, trademarks or logos of other entities.
7. Entries that violate the rules set out in paragraphs 4-6 above will be rejected by Us and will not participate in the Contest.

§ 4. SCHEDULE AND METHOD OF SELECTING THE WINNERS

1. Schedule of the Competition editions:
 - a. **Edition I:** 14 July 2026 – announcement of edition I of the Competition on X; 14–19 July 2026 – submission period; 20 July–3 September 2026 – evaluation of Entries and announcement of the results.
 - b. **Edition II:** 28 July 2026 – announcement of edition II of the Competition on Instagram; 28 July–2 August 2026 – submission period; 3 August–3 September 2026 – evaluation of Entries and announcement of the results.
 - c. **Edition III:** 11 August 2026 – announcement of edition III of the Competition on Reddit and Discord; 11–16 August 2026 – submission period; 17 August–3 September 2026 – evaluation of Entries and announcement of the results.

2. The end of each period specified above falls at 11:59 p.m. CEST (Central European Summer Time) on the relevant end date.
3. One (1) winner ("**Winner**") will be selected for each edition of the Contest.
4. The Winner will be selected by a Contest committee consisting of three members of the Rebel Wolves team ("**Committee**"). The Committee evaluates Entries based on the following criteria: consistency with the nature of the Song, creativity and originality. The Entry that receives the highest overall score from the Committee will be considered the Winner.

§ 5. PRIZES

1. The Winner will receive a prize in the form of a Collector's Edition Game ("**Prize**"). In addition, Rebel Wolves may use the Winner Entry as the official name of the Song (Rebel Wolves is not obligated to use the Entry).
2. We will transfer the Prize to You after 3.09.2026. To transfer the Prize, We will need an address to which We can deliver the Prize to You. Rebel Wolves will contact You via a message in the Channel through which You made your Entry within five (5) business days of the announcement of the Winner of the respective edition of the Contest to arrange the shipment details. We stipulate that in the event that You do not provide us with shipping details or refuse to accept the Prize within fourteen (14) days of receiving a message from Rebel Wolves, the Prize will be forfeited.
3. Rebel Wolves reserves the right to award other special prizes (honorable mentions) at its sole discretion.
4. Rebel Wolves will cover the shipping costs of the Prize, however Rebel Wolves will make one attempt to deliver the shipment. The Participant understands that the delivery of the Prize to certain locations may be significantly hindered or impossible for reasons beyond the control of Rebel Wolves.
5. In the event that the delivery address of the Prize provided by the Winner is located in a territory to which the delivery of the Prize is impossible or significantly hindered for reasons beyond the control of Rebel Wolves, Rebel Wolves may contact the Winner to determine an alternative place for the delivery of the Prize.
6. Rebel Wolves is not responsible for the shipment in the event that the details provided by the Winner do not correspond to the actual identity of the recipient, which may result in the shipment being rejected or delayed in transit.
7. We will not be able to award a Prize if your account on the Channel through which You submitted your Entry was deleted or blocked before the Prize was distributed. In this case, Rebel Wolves is not obliged to award the Prize or pay the equivalent.
8. Prizes cannot be transferred to third parties or exchanged for cash.

9. Rebel Wolves will cover the costs of the tax due on the Prize in accordance with Polish law. In addition, Participants are solely responsible for the payment of any additional national, federal, state, local, or other taxes of any kind related to the Prize.
10. Upon request of Rebel Wolves, the Participant is required to provide Rebel Wolves with all documents and information required by applicable law. These documents and information may include, in particular, data required for the fulfilment of tax obligations, related to anti-money laundering or anti-fraud and must be provided within seven (7) days from the date of delivery of the Rebel Wolves request to the Participant. Where applicable, prior to the transfer of the Prize, upon request of Rebel Wolves, the Participant is required to provide Rebel Wolves with a current and valid tax residence certificate issued by the country in which the Participant is a tax resident.

§ 5. PARTICIPANT STATEMENTS

1. By entering the Contest, by submitting an Entry, You agree to the terms and conditions of the Contest set out in the Rules.
2. By submitting the Entry, You also declare that:
 - a. the Entry is the result of your own individual work;
 - b. in the event that the Entry is a work within the meaning of the Act of 4 February 1994 on copyright and related rights: (i) You have all moral and economic rights to the Entry, in particular the right to use it and dispose of it in all fields of exploitation and to receive remuneration for the use of the Entry; (ii) You have the exclusive right to grant consent to the exercise of your derivative rights in the Entry; (iii) your economic rights referred to above are not limited or encumbered by the rights of third parties and do not infringe any rights of any third party; (iv) You have not granted any license to use the Entry to any extent.
3. To the extent that the Contest takes place on Instagram, the Participant declares that they:
 - a. releases Meta from any and all liability related to the organization and conduct of this Contest;
 - b. acknowledges that the Contest is in no way sponsored, endorsed by, administered by, or affiliated with Meta in any way.

§ 6. COPYRIGHT AND USE OF THE ENTRIES BY REBEL WOLVES

1. Please note that all intellectual property rights associated with the Game and the Song remain the exclusive property of Rebel Wolves. Participants do not acquire any rights to the Game, Song or elements thereof by participating in the Contest or by creating Entries.
2. In the event that the Entry is a work within the meaning of the Act of 4 February 1994 on copyright and related rights, the provisions set out in the following paragraphs shall apply to such Entry.

[License to use the Participant Entry]

3. By submitting an Entry, You grant Rebel Wolves a non-exclusive, worldwide, royalty-free license to use the Entry (i.e. a new Song title created by You) for purposes related to the Contest, including to make the Entry available to Users and to publish it on Our websites, including the Channels. The license covers in particular the following fields of exploitation:
- production of copies of the Entry using all techniques;
 - distribute and share the Entry across all channels;
 - making the Entry available in a way that allows any person to access it at a place and time chosen by that person.

[Acquisition of copyright in the winning Entry]

4. Rebel Wolves reserves, pursuant to Article 921 § 3 of the Act of 23 April 1964 – the Civil Code (hereinafter the "**Civil Code**"), that upon delivery of the Prize, to the maximum extent permitted by the applicable provisions of law, it acquires the economic copyrights to the awarded Entry (i.e. the new title of the Song created by You), to the extent that it constitutes a work, without territorial or time limitations, together with the right to authorize the exercise of derivative rights and to transfer the rights or grant licenses to third parties (the Entry to which Rebel Wolves acquires the economic copyrights is hereinafter the "**Work**").
5. The acquisition of the economic copyrights to the Work shall cover all fields of exploitation known as of the date of preparation of these Rules, including in particular:
- recording or reproducing the Work, in whole or in part, by any technique and in any form;
 - distributing the Work and its adaptations, in whole or in part, in any manner and in any form;
 - public performance, exhibition, display, reproduction, broadcasting and rebroadcasting of the Work, as well as making it publicly available in such a way that anyone may access it at a place and time individually chosen by them (including via the Internet);
 - introducing the Work into a computer memory, IT systems, ICT networks and databases;
 - making any changes, alterations, adaptations and modifications to the Work, both by Rebel Wolves and by third parties acting with the consent of Rebel Wolves, and distributing the adaptations of the Work created in this way;
 - placing the original or copies of the Work into circulation, lending or renting the original or copies of the Work;
 - using the Work independently or in combination with other materials, trademarks, graphics, promotional or informational materials of Rebel Wolves;
 - using the Work for the promotional, advertising, informational, marketing, documentary and image-building purposes of Rebel Wolves, the Game or Rebel Wolves' products, in particular on the Internet, social media, press materials,

presentations, promotional materials and other communication channels of Rebel Wolves.

6. The Winner agrees that Rebel Wolves may exercise its derivative copyrights in the Work, including the making of derivative works and use of such works without the need for separate permission.
7. The Winner undertakes not to exercise any moral rights to the Work and authorizes Rebel Wolves to exercise the moral rights to the Work on its behalf, in particular to decide on the attribution, the manner of marking the Work and to distribute it without attribution.
8. To the extent that the transfer of the economic copyrights to the Work to Rebel Wolves proves to be wholly or partially ineffective due to mandatory provisions of law, the Winner grants Rebel Wolves a non-exclusive, worldwide, royalty-free licence, with the right to grant sublicences, to use the Work in the fields of exploitation specified in section 5, to the extent that the transfer of rights has not taken effect. Furthermore, in such a case, Rebel Wolves reserves the right to require the Winner to enter into an agreement transferring the economic copyrights to the Work in the fields of exploitation specified in section 5, based on the template agreement designated by Rebel Wolves.

§ 7. PROTECTION OF PERSONAL DATA

1. The controller of your personal data processed as part of the Contest is Rebel Wolves. You can contact Us at the address given in § 1 section 1 or by e-mail at office@rebel-wolves.com.
2. Your personal data will be processed for the purpose of organizing and conducting the Contest; compliance with legal obligations incumbent on Rebel Wolves; any establishing, pursuing or defending against claims related to the Contest; marketing, including in order to inform about the results of the Contest and to promote the activities of Rebel Wolves.
3. You have the right to: request access to data, rectification, portability, deletion or restriction of data processing, object to data processing, lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority.

§ 8. FINAL PROVISIONS

1. The Rules have been prepared in two language versions - Polish and English. In the event of discrepancies between the language versions, the Polish version shall prevail.
2. The Rules are governed by Polish law.
3. The Rules are the only document defining the rules of the Contest. All other materials, in particular those published on the Channels, are for informational purposes only.



4. The Contest does not depend on chance, is not based on guessing, and is not a cash lottery, a prize lottery, a promotional lottery, or any other game of chance or mutual betting within the meaning of the Act of 19 November 2009 on gambling.
5. Rebel Wolves does not cover any costs incurred by the Participant in connection with the Contest, including costs related to participation in the Contest, the preparation and submission of the Entry or the receipt of the Prize.
6. All questions related to the Contest can be sent to the e-mail address: community@rebel-wolves.com.
7. Rebel Wolves may make changes to the Rules during the Contest if necessary to clarify the rules of the Contest. The changes made will not affect the rights of the Participants acquired before their introduction. Any change to the Rules will be effective from the moment it is posted on the Channels.
8. The Rules enter into force on July 14, 2026.
